The Surgical Technician works hand in hand with the nurses and physicians to deliver the highest standard of patient care. This position assists in the organization and daily function of the operating room in accordance with established Federal, State and accreditation standards and surgery center policies and procedures.

Minimum Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Successful completion of a Surgical Technician technical program. Certification as a surgical technician preferred.
- Operating room experience required, (2) years of hospital main operating room experience desired.
- Current CPR certification required.

Eligibility:

- All employees must be able to provide proof of their identity and their right to work in the United States.
- Must pass a pre-employment background check and pre-employment physical

Skills/Knowledge/Ability:

Interpersonal: Effective communication skills; oral and written. Demonstrates a positive, friendly, and courteous manner. Serves as a role model to other staff members. Demonstrates the ability to work well with other employees.

Critical Thinking: Ability to organize equipment, instruments, and supplies for cases according to patient needs and physician preference cards. Ability to adhere to the work schedule and manage time appropriately. Assumes responsibility for competency and takes initiative for professional development and continuing education. Ability to handle stress associated with prioritizing multiple tasks. Above average organization skills.

Knowledge: Working knowledge and experience in a hospital, operating room, or ambulatory surgery center. Ability to anticipate the needs of the physician and has equipment, medical gases and supplies readily available for all procedures. Ability to scrub all types of cases preferred. Ensures that an adequate amount of in-house supplies and medical gases are available in accordance with weekly caseload.
